I am requesting funding for Monroe County Control Center (MCC) Interoperable Public Safety Radio System Implementation project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Monroe County Control Center, located at 100 Gypsum Road Stroudsburg, PA 18360. The funding would be used for the implementation of a countywide interoperable radio system, including infrastructure, equipment, and coverage enhancements to ensure reliable, secure communications for law enforcement.
